

On Tuesday, November 24th, the Kansas State High School Activities Association called a special board of directors meeting where several items were adopted that will affect our currently scheduled winter activities at Twin Valley Schools.

(A summary of the impacts that these decisions will have on our school and our winter activities is below.)

The most dramatic change is the activities association approved a NO SPECTATOR POLICY that will be in place from December 1st through January 28th for all winter activities to mitigate possible COVID-19 spikes following the next two holidays.

- No spectators allowed from Dec 1st thru Jan 28th for any/all activities (Basketball, Wrestling, Music, Scholars Bowl) at all levels
- Limited spectators may be possible beginning Jan 29th
- No practices allowed from Dec 23rd thru Jan 3rd (winter moratorium)
- No contests allowed from Dec 23rd thru Jan 7th
- Basketball tournaments may continue with a maximum of 4 teams playing at a given time
- 8 team tournaments are still allowed
- No change in the maximum number of Basketball games allowed
- Wrestling tournaments are allowed up to 8 teams or 112 participants
- No change in the maximum number of Wrestling events/pts allowed
- Face coverings are REQUIRED to be worn PROPERLY by EVERYONE except those on the floor actively competing and the officials during play
