Online Enrollment

Online enrollment will be available July 27 through PowerSchool. To enroll your child online, go to www.usd240.org, click on "Online Enrollment" in the navigation bar on the left.

Returning students will click on the "Start Here" link next to returning students on the right, then login using your PowerSchool login, and click on forms to start the process.

New Students will click on the "Start Here" link next to new students on the left, complete the initial information. Within 72 hours you will receive an email with additional information to complete the enrollment process.

In-Person Enrollment

We will have technology available to complete the enrollment process at the building. In-person is for those unable to complete the online enrollment process independently.

One of the changes for the 2021-22 school year is regarding free lunches for all students. The USDA announced they will continue free breakfast and lunch for another year as families recover from the pandemic. This is great news for all of our students!

How to pay enrollment fees?

- ✦ Send a check to the appropriate building according to the enrollment fees sheet.
- ✦ Pay Online - On the Enrollment Information page, click on "Online Payment".
(There is a 3.6% processing fee for the online payment option.)
- ✦ Textbook fee can be paid at a later date upon determination of income eligibility.

information regarding household income for a variety of purposes. The information gathered on the Household Economic Survey (HES) generates additional funding for our local educational programs. We encourage all families to consider providing the information included in the HES. Eligibility determination will be made according to the federally established guidelines. If your family qualifies, the district receives funds accordingly. A few additional reasons for this consideration include:

- ✦ Families that qualify receive other district benefits, such as reduced textbook fees.
- ✦ State funding for our school district may be reduced if families don't provide the information.

The Kansas State Department of Education (KSDE) has approved the use of the Household Economic Survey to gather the necessary information. Household income and a list of the people living in the household is the only information requested. No other information is needed.

I encourage you to consider providing this information during the enrollment process. The information will not be shared with any other agency and will only be used for eligibility purposes for reduced fees and for data submission to the KSDE regarding at-risk and title services.
