

Minutes of the special meeting of the Board of Education held on January 24, 2022 at the Unified District Office. Those present were Robert Miller, Ray Swearingen, Jeff Shamburg and Darrin Hurd, by Zoom: Jeremiah Van Doren; Principals Mettlen, Kimmi and Gantenbein; Superintendent Pam Irwin, Clerk Cindy Regnier and 1 guest.

President Robert Miller called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. The agenda for the meeting was adopted. Motion by Ray Swearingen, seconded by Jeff Shamburg. Motion carried 5-0.

Discussion followed regarding changes to Covid protocol. Motion by Darrin Hurd to adopt the agreed upon procedures outlined as follows:

1. Eliminate Contact Tracing
2. Test with parent permission any symptomatic student
3. A symptomatic student not tested will be sent home for 5 days at which time they may return with a negative test and a mask for 5 days
4. Household contacts will be expected to isolate from positive family members and tested for 5 days. May remain in school with negative tests. Masks required for 10 days
5. Any student in the testing protocol will not be allowed to ride the bus in the morning, but can ride the bus after school with a negative test.

Seconded by Jeff Shamburg. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Jeff Shamburg to accept the resignation of Melissa Larson as Tescott music instructor effective with the close of the 21-22 school year. Seconded by Darrin Hurd. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Jeff Shamburg to approve the hiring of Barbara Ramsay as tutor pending background check results. Seconded by Ray Swearingen. Motion carried 5-0.

President Robert Miller adjourned the meeting.
